Estate planning, which includes the creation of a will, a living trust, and other protective documents, allows you to decide how your wealth, health and business matters will be handled when you pass away or are unable to make decisions.

communities.

“[People with special needs] are a vulnerable group who require even more protection,” Prosser says. A Special Needs Trust allows parents to appoint an appropriate guardian and give instructions for their child’s education, housing and personal needs.
